ChoiceNet, our tiered provider network, includes thousands of Harvard Pilgrim's participating doctors and clinicians, plus more than 130 hospitals, who have met Harvard Pilgrim's high standards for providing quality care. You will pay different cost sharing based on a provider's assigned benefit tier.¹

When you see participating providers in a lower tier, you'll pay less. You pay more when you receive services from higher tier providers. Refer to your Harvard Pilgrim *Schedule of Benefits* to determine your plan's actual cost sharing.

If you have established relationships with certain doctors, you'll want to find out what tiers they are in before receiving care from them. Just because doctors are affiliated with certain hospitals, it doesn't mean that they'll have the same tier level.
